Health Insurance

Health insurance policies are important; they help pay for some, but not all of your health care costs. Health insurance companies are *not* Doctors, *can't* practice medicine, or determine medical necessity.

Health insurance companies will generally *not pay* for all services, especially *newer, state of the art treatments*. Sometimes they state this up front; other times, they decide *only after* the treatment. This can create a problem; your insurance can *refuse to pay after* you've received treatment.

Billing & Payment

To continue to *deliver excellence* to our clients, our policy is simple:

- For treatments that are covered by health insurance, we ask that all patient responsibility amounts (co-payment, co-insurance, and deductible) be paid at the time of your visit.
- For treatments that are not covered, we ask you to waive your contractual coverage and be responsible for the associated costs.

Convenience

We keep credit cards securely on file to pay for incidental charges, such as copayment, co-insurance and deductible amounts; We always notify patients prior to any charges.
